Dear Parents / Guardians of Division 2,


Please find below the supplies list for the MACC 6/7 classroom.

**\* Please label all items you can with student's first name and last initial \***

1. A cloth zipper or flexible pencil/supplies case to hold loose markers and pencils. No supply pencil boxes, either metal or plastic, as it needs to fit in the backpack, and we do not have table storage for them.
2. Duotangs (3-prong in 5 different colors: RED, YELLOW, GREEN, BLUE, ORANGE)
  - a. Optional: These can be substituted for a multi subject binder
3. One, 1-inch thick, 3 ring binder. Any color is fine.
4. A pack of 8- or 12-tab dividers for three ring binder
5. 1 package of lined paper (500 sheets)
6. 1 ruler
7. Pencils (3 packages),
8. 3 white erasers,
9. A handheld pencil sharpener with container for shavings,
10. 1 pocket French-English dictionary,

*Please put 4 pencils and one eraser in the supplies bag and keep extras at home. Please avoid mechanical pencils.*

11. Set of 12, thin-tipped, multi-color markers.
12. Set of 12, thick-tipped, multi-color markers.
13. One set of 12 colored pencil crayons.
14. A small hand sized, basic calculator.
15. A small, handheld, plastic protractor or a small math set. The protractor is the most helpful.



16. 2 black, thin tipped, Sharpie black fine liners

17. 4 glue sticks

18. A durable pair of pointed scissors

19. One pair of inside running shoes that will stay at school all year

20. Weather appropriate attire: raincoats, waterproof shoes, jackets, hats, mittens, etc.

21. One large water bottle

22. 1 set of earbuds or compact/foldable headphones

23. 1 small, personal bottle of hand sanitizer (unscented)

24. A personal pack of tissues (to be replenished as needed)

25. 1 small sealable bag for waste (snack wrappers, juice boxes, or other food packaging / waste)
